

## **Battle Creek Transit (BCT) Title VI Notice**

Effective Date: July 1, 2013

In compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, BCT operates all of its programs and provides public transportation services without regard to race, color, or national origin. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a written complaint with the City of Battle Creek.
