2016-2019	2016	Downtown Riverfront/MillPond Redevelopment	General Fund, State Grant Funds	Construction of Linear Path along Kalamazoo River from Washington to Fountain. Construct a new park facility with turf restoration, shelters and parking lot on Kalamazoo River.	\$900,000
